
We hope you have as much fun reading about The Safety Friends and doing the fun exercises as our team did in creating the comic book!

Only eleven states rank lower in safety belt use than Missouri.

What are Drivers' Odds?



IN A CRASH:

Unbelted - 1 in 29 chance of being killed. Belted - 1 in 1,258 chance of being killed.

Missouri has an 87% safety belt usage rate, yet the remaining 13% unbelted account for over 60% of vehicle occupant fatalities.


While Driving

In 2018, Missouri EXCEEDED 900 traffic fatalities for the third year in a row.



Missouri is ONE of THREE states without a no texting law for all drivers...

...and ONE of TEN states without a hands-free law for either all drivers or novice drivers.



Since 2014, cell phone related crashes in Missouri have increased by 35 percent, with nearly 2,600 crashes in 2017.


